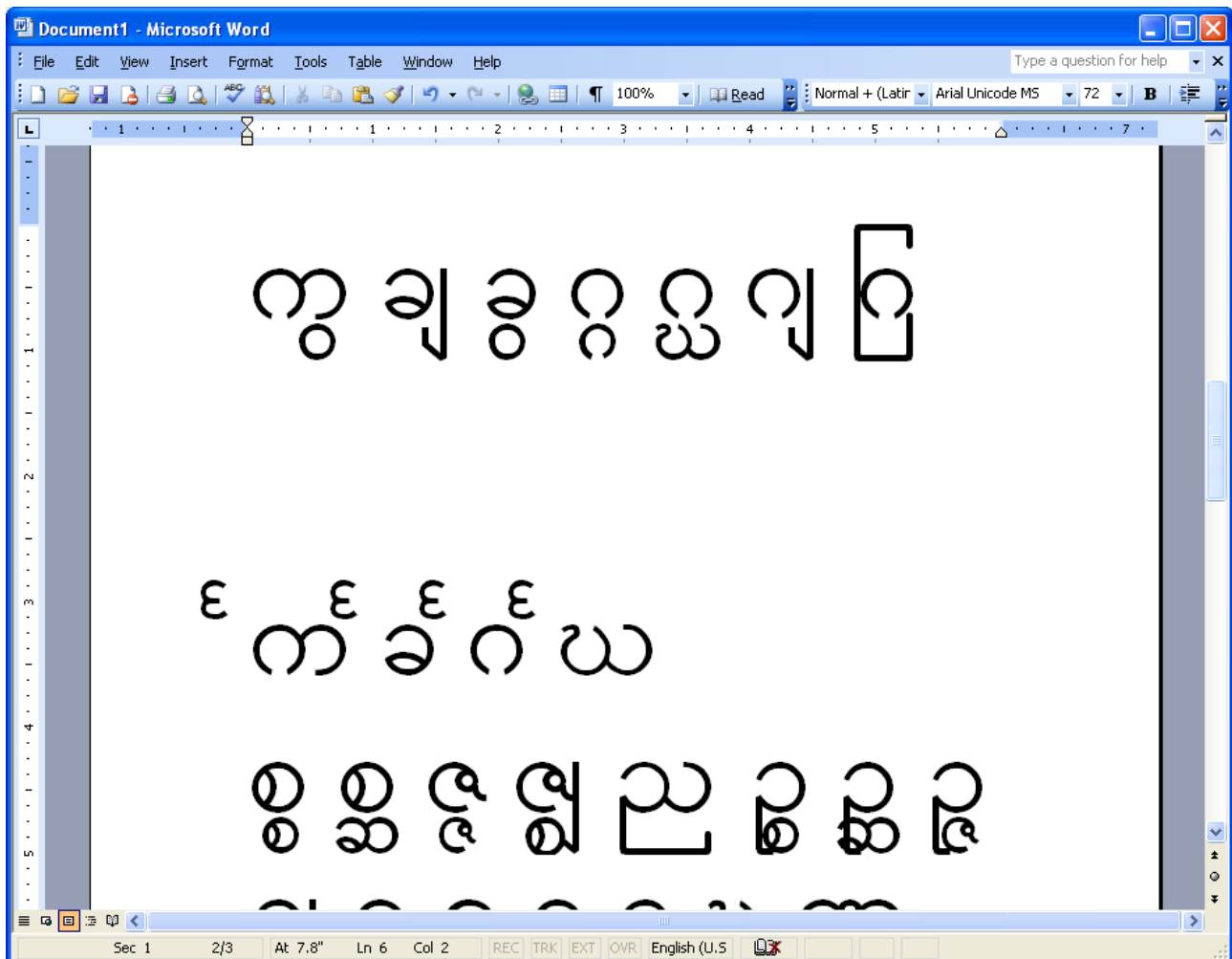
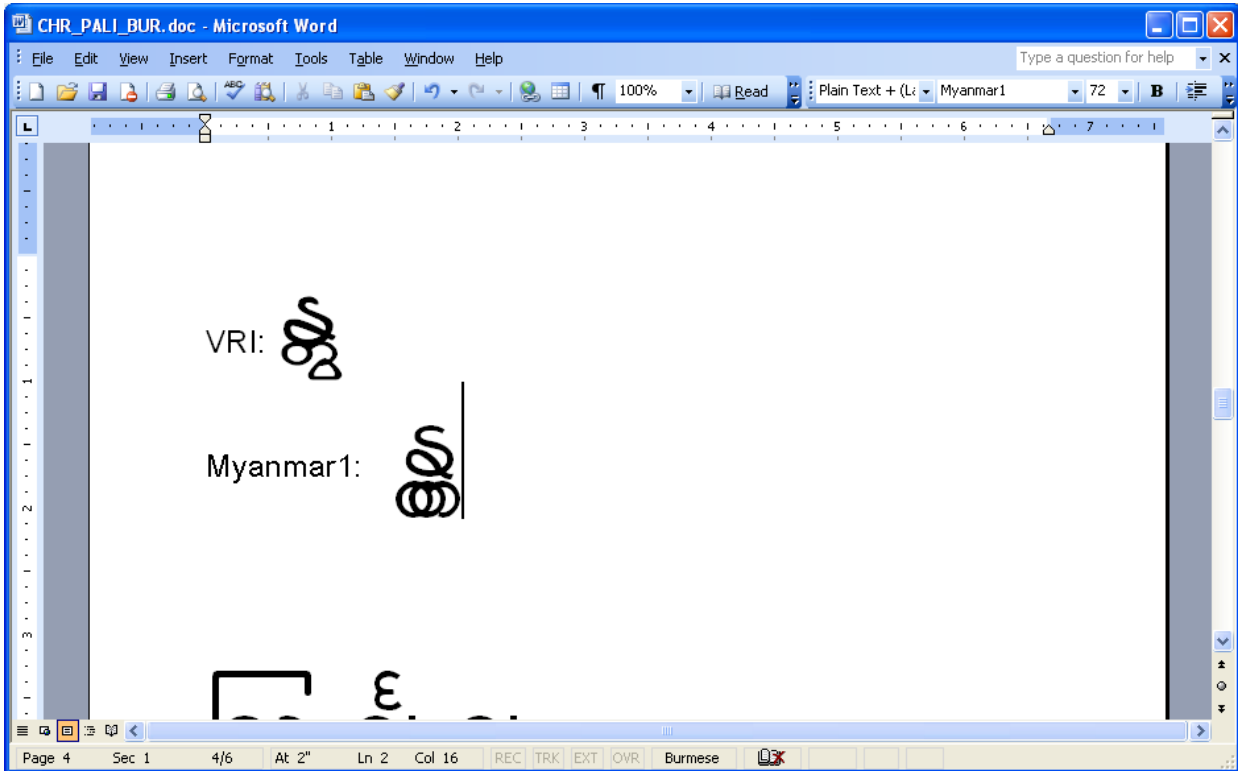


Known issues with Myanmar font

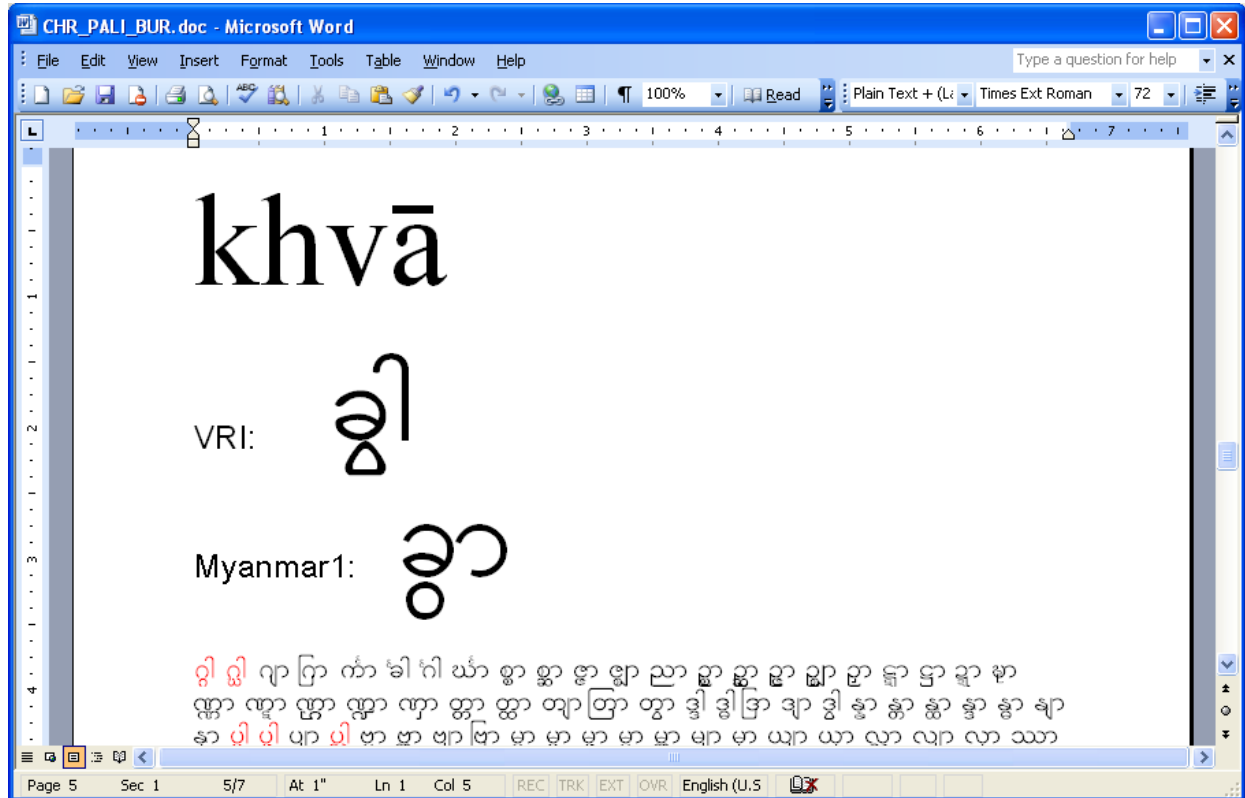
1. Myanmar1 doesn't know how to join **ng** with **ka**, **kha**, **ga** and **gha**.



2) **ntva** is not displayed properly in Myanmar1. The subscript ta and va are on top of each other.



3) **khvaa**. The upsidedown J is the long “a” sign. The other form of the “aa” sign looks like a circle with the lower left part missing. Unicode represents them both as a single character “aa”. It's up to the font to decide which one should be shown. Generally, tall characters get the upsidedown J form and normal height characters get the half circle form.



4) **kru**. - Much like the “aa” sign, “u” has short and tall forms and the font is responsible for deciding which one to use.
